8/7/1560	0	Elizabeth “Erzebet” Bathory born to George and Anna Bathory
		Spent her childhood in Ecsed Castle
	4-5	Elizabeth had quite violent seizures where she would ultimate pass out
		One uncle was known to be a devil-worshiper and other members of the family were mentally insane and perverted
		Saw her two sisters raped and hanged
		Saw their murderer put on hot iron throne and burned to death
1571	11	Elizabeth was forced to become engaged to Count Nadasdy
1574	14	Elizabeth gave birth to an illegitimate child fathered by a peasant boy
5/8/1575	15	Elizabeth marries Count Ferencz Nadasdy, who was 25 years old
		They moved to castle Cachtice which lies over the north-western part of Hungry
		Count Ferencz spent a lot of time away from home fighting against the Turks
1585	25	
	20-40	While Elizabeth’s husband was away she found herself spending more time admiring her beauty in the mirror
	20-40	She took on young men as lovers and even ran off with one but the Count forgave her
	20-40	While home alone, Elizabeth would pay visits to her aunt, Countess Klara Bathory, who was an open bisexual
	20-40	Elizabeth’s aunt was a nymphomaniac and enjoyed killing people in the Roman way
	20-40	Her aunt killed two of her four husbands and eventually she was raped by an entire Turkish garrison before being stabbed to death
	20-40	Elizabeth became acquainted with the art of inflicting pain and suffering
	20-40	Elizabeth started a fascination with Black Magic

	20-40	A servant, Thorko, in Elizabeth's castle started teaching her the ways of witchcraft and the same time encouraging her sadistic tendencies
	20-40	One day Elizabeth wrote to her husband, "Thorko has taught me a lovely new one. Catch a black hen and beat it to death with a white can. Keep the blood and smear a little of it on your enemy. If you get no chance to smear it on his body, obtain one of his garments and smear it"
	20-40	While he was home, Count Ferencz would torture the servants and give Elizabeth lessons from what he learned at torturing war prisoners
1/4/16-4	44	Ferencz Nadasdy dies apparently of poisoning but some believed it could be witchcraft
12/30/1610		A band of soldiers that were led by Elizabeth's cousin raided Castled Csejthe
1611		Elizabeth's trial takes place and a register of over 650 victims were found in her living quarters
