July 7, 1906	0	Born in the town of Fuessen in Bavaria, Germany to Georg and Katharina Filser. She was the last of 12 children, 9 of them being boys. At the time of Anna Marie's birth her parents had lost 3 children and 2 of their boys were killed in action during WWI.
		As a young girl she spent 5 months in the hospital due to blood poisoning. She thought she was going to die several times.
		Underwent a goiter operation soon after her sickness. (removal of the thyroid gland)
		Being the youngest girl, she was her mother's favorite. During her teenage years she strayed from her parents and was used to getting her way. She was known to sneak out of the house windows late at night and go to parties.
		Anna never completed high school but will later claim to have along with graduating from "teaching school".
		Parents shipped her off to her sister, Katti's house in Holland to help straighten out her disciplinary problems.
